Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • First Watch FCU has no affiliates.			
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • First Watch FCU does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.			
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Our joint marketing partner is an insurance company.			

Other important information

When First Watch FCU provides information to a nonaffiliate for joint marketing purposes, we require a written agreement in which they agree to adhere to privacy principles and standards consistent with those of First Watch FCU.
